Team Commitment Overview:

What is the Hello Team?

The Hello Team is open to all High School students. Every weekend we welcome students and families into our worship space. Some people come every week and others are our guests for just a week or two. We are the first to say “hello” and look to proactively connect students & their peers into what is happening at Highlands. Relationships matter to us and this team is for those who have a heart to help their friends and our guests to feel known.

Who can serve?

If you are a student in High School who has a heart for people. Additionally, we ask that you attend the Sunday morning gathering regularly and participate in a d-group.

I don’t know what I am doing, will I get training?

The great thing about this team is that if you join us on Sunday morning and are able to show up a bit early, all the training is simple! You will get some specific training and encouragement each week about how to welcome others, specific answers to common questions, and a heads up on what is coming before others. Here is the basic regular commitment:

- Step 1: Arrive Sunday’s around 10:45 am.
- Step 2: Check in with the team leaders.
- Step 3: Be the first ones to say “hello” to students and guests as they come in.

A Few Other Details:

- If there are other outside time commitments besides Sunday mornings, we will communicate those well in advance for your planning.
- There are additional roles of signing postcards, sending texts and following up with guests after the Sunday gathering.
- We welcome your ideas for different ways to best help every student feel welcomed.
