What is the Media Team?

It is one of several very valuable teams in Student Ministries. The media team's primary role is to produce the sound and visual elements of the environment each weekend where Jesus is worshipped, the Scriptures are taught and relationships are deepened. Both the Middle School and the High School gatherings rely on this team as integral in fulfilling our mission each Sunday and at special events! We set up, run the soundboard, cameras, lights, and ProPresenter (slides and media).

Step 1: On the job training for two weeks to evaluate the opportunity.

Step 2: Join by becoming part of the regularly scheduled team.

Step 3: Consistently check email/app to stay on top of upcoming commitment.

A Few Other Details:

- Scheduling: Once on the team we ask that you check your email for when you are scheduled. We use an online scheduling tool called [planningcenteronline](http://planningcenteronline.com) and will help you get set up.
- Weekend Call Time: Once on the team depending on your role we ask you arrive the weeks you are scheduled in time for set up, rehearsal and team prayer.
- We will provide several additional training and team building times throughout the year and appreciate you prioritizing your involvement in these times as best as possible.
- We appreciate your flexibility as the year unfolds!
