TEAM DETAILS & UNDERSTANDINGS

- Bible Quiz Team (BQT) is for 7-12th grade students.
- It is led by a team designated by and accountable to the Student Ministries staff. If you would like to be part of the team, please let the team leader know (Jeff Maison) and we can walk through the steps of adding you to the leadership team.
- BQT is focused on quizzing competition to help motivate Bible memory and application.
- BQT, along with all ministries, is continually evaluated as part of the overall ministry discipleship strategy within Student Ministries.
- We recognize that BQT is not for every student.
- We commit to speak and act in a way that demonstrates unity with staff, leadership, parents and quizzers. This is a high value and imperative for student and leader involvement on any team as part of Highlands Student Ministry.

- It is a ministry to HCC families, and while there are students welcomed from other churches, it is primarily an HCC ministry.
- We commit to be actively involved in the broader HCC Student Ministries for holistic growth (Dgroups, Sundays, serving, camps).
- We understand Bible memory can be accomplished through a variety of methods. The competition aspect of Bible memory is a preference for how to accomplish Bible memory. Bible memory is valued and practiced along with the other spiritual disciplines within the broader Highlands Student Ministries.
- We understand extra BQT events and commitments are evaluated alongside the HCC Student Ministries calendar objectives and commitments.
- We understand the expectation that BQT is to be more than knowledge-based, and will continually strive for relevant application. BQT will strive to engage culture rather than retreat from it.
- We understand BQT is staff directed and the BQT leadership, parents and students must share the values, vision and direction of the Highlands Student Ministries leadership to participate.
- We understand BQT will culminate at the IFCA regionals (September – April).

NATIONAL CONVENTION INVOLVEMENT

- We understand that pending leadership and interest on the part of the team there is a potential of attending the IFCA National Convention as follows:
 - We understand there is no expectation to send a team to Nationals every year.
 - We understand if the decision is made to send a team that it would be a senior team to the IFCA Nationals. (“Seniors” are defined as those who are in their third full year of quizzing having completed at least two prior full years of the Bible memory commitment.)
