### TRAVEL INFORMATION

Please arrive promptly at 9:00 am on Saturday, July 24 in the lower parking lot to load your gear and check in. We will depart shortly thereafter. We'll arrive back in the HCC lower parking lot at approximately 4:30 pm on Thursday, July 29.

### PACKING LIST

### BAPTISMS AT CAMP

### MAIL AT CAMP

Parents are welcome to drop off mail for your student at check in on Saturday. We will then distribute it at camp on Sunday through Wednesday.

## **CELL PHONES**

We discourage sending a cell phone to camp/retreat with your student. An important purpose of our time away is for people to connect face-to-face and be removed from the distractions of social media. Students may always be contacted at camp through the staff contact numbers provided. If a student brings a cell phone, we will ask him/her to put it away. Please note that we are not responsible for misplaced, lost or stolen items.

## **WHAT NOT TO BRING**

Gaming systems, fireworks, weapons, knives of any size/kind, matches, tobacco, drugs, alcohol, or any items for pranks. These items undermine the purpose of camp and will not be allowed. We appreciate your cooperation with us in creating a fun and safe environment.
